Over the years I have been speaking with teachers and heads to help them develop their innovative visions and ideas into physical products that solve real problems and make real differences in an educational setting.

I have compiled this toolkit that lists some of the best ways to solve problems that your school may be dealing with right now, and ways you can transform the attitudes and achievements of your pupils. The solutions are simple and straight forward I am very confident they will work for you.























#### STREAMLINE YOUR SCHOOL DINNER TIME, REDUCE WASTE AND CREATE POSITIVE ENGAGEMENT FROM THE PUPILS.

The cost to implement this system is extremely low, especially when weighed up against the benefits it brings.

WRAP (Waste and Resources Action Programme) conducted a research project and have devised this now well tested and proven system.





This simple system allows pupils to choose their preferred meal option each morning, at which point they are given a coloured silicone wristband corresponding to their meal choice. The numbers of pupils selecting each meal option are communicated to the kitchen, allowing staff to cook the correct number of portions of each. On entering the dining hall those serving the cooked meals can see at a glance which option each pupil has ordered from their coloured wristband.









- Reducing food waste.
- Pupils are actively involved in planning their meal choice and take ownership of this process.
- Parents and carers, especially those of younger pupils, are happy to be involved in choosing their pupil's meal at home.

- Pupils enjoy wearing wristbands and have a positive attitude towards school meals.
- Queueing times are reduced, since pupils have made their meal choice before arriving at the serving counter.
- Administrative errors relating to the payment for school meals are reduced, saving the school money.

Supermarkets sell very affordable school uniforms, they are available all year round, parents and carers can pick up the uniforms with their weekly shop and the supermarkets often offer multi-buy deals.


**However**, you may have had **reservations**, as you believe it is important to **display the school's logo or emblem on the uniforms**.

The solution, is to offer embroidered or woven patches to parents and carers that they can sew-on to the uniforms at designated positions.

SCHOOLS HAVE A RESPONSIBILITY TO LET PARENTS AND CARERS KNOW IF A PUPIL HAS HAD AN INCIDENT AT SCHOOL, SUCH AS: A BUMP ON THE

HEAD, AN ALLERGIC REACTION, OR A FALL.

If a staff member is not able to speak to the parent or carer directly, a letter is sent home with the pupil.

In most cases the parent or carer will hear about the incident from the child. If the letter has been forgotten, lost or damaged, the parent or carer can become upset or angry that they have not been notified.



Tyvek Wristbands with printed messages describing the incident are a really successful solution.

Older pupils who are heading off on a school trip are often given more independence to explore and experience a different city or environment.

## MULTIPLICATION WRISTBANDS ARE A GREAT WAY FOR PUPILS TO LEARN THEIR TIMES-TABLES ANYTIME AND ANYWHERE.



Pupils love to wear wristbands, especially when they glow in the dark!

These wristbands come as a set of 12. Each wristband has the full times-table printed on it and can be customised with your school logo or custom messages (or they are available without any branding).

The idea is that after each times-table has been completed, pupils are rewarded with the next one, all the way up to 12, which is gold for the final achievement.





- · Cheap and fun.
- Collecting all the wristbands and being rewarded with something to wear is a massive incentive for pupils.
- Learning can spark anytime and anywhere, even in the bath or shower!
- x6, x7, x8, x9 and x10 glow in the dark so there is sense of achievement on the way to completing the set.
- x12 is gold, to mark completion of the set.
- A great fundraiser item for schools/PTAs.

MANY SCHOOLS USE A SIMILAR INITIATIVE: MULTIPLICATION REWARD WRISTBANDS.

Once a pupil has reached a certain level they are awarded with a silicone wristband which covers a range of levels, rather than 1 at a time, for example:

x2, x10, x5 = Red wristband x3, x4, x8 = Blue wristband UP TO x12 = Gold wristband





These wristbands can be customised with with your logo or emblem, can be in any colour, be glow in the dark, or purchased from stock with no school customisation.



Awarding merit patches is a proven way to encourage pupils to reach new heights in their education and personal development.

Merit patches encourage pupils to explore areas that interest them and to teach values and skills.

The merit patch program is completely open to variation. You can award pupils in anyway you like and reward them with completely unique patch designs.





### HERE IS A CASE STUDY OF HOW A SCHOOL USED THE MERIT PATCH SYSTEM:

Each pupil is given an affordable sash in their house colours.

Patches are presented during assembly with a certificate (printed at school) with the patch attached using a paperclip.

The school values are: Aspiration, Inspiration, Fortitude & Unity.

Merit patches are awarded for demonstrating any of the values in school or home life, for example:

A pupil who has a passion for animals and nature starts and maintains a nature themed YouTube channel, working with their family and friends, entertaining people, learning about nature and gaining new skills.



THIS COULD BE AWARDED WITH THE ASPIRATION OR INSPIRATION MERIT PATCH

A pupil has broken their ankle, they have a cast and are on crutches, but the injury doesn't hold them back from participating in normal school lessons and activities, in fact nothing holds them back and their attitude is completely positive and unaffected.





THIS PUPIL COULD BE AWARDED WITH THE FORTITUDE MERIT PATCH.



#### MERITS PATCHES ARE ALSO AWARDED IN THREE STAGES FOR:

- Good behaviour.
- Hitting targets.
- Reading.
- · Communication.
- · Curriculum.







AWARDING COLOURS STARTED AS A TRADITION IN UNIVERSITIES AND PRIVATE SCHOOLS FOR PUPILS THAT EXCELLED IN SPORTS.

This tradition is now common in schools and academies for a very good reason, the promise of an award pushes pupils to do better and have that effort and hard work recognised.

The opportunity for success to be acknowledged and rewarded reflects and cultivates positivity throughout the school.

Colours are no-longer just for sports though, **non-sporting pupils are also recognised.** Colours can be awarded for any category you like, from drama, to help in the community.



Pin badges are the most common way of representing these achievements. Improvements in production techniques and affordability means you can now create awards in many different and contemporary styles, as well as traditionally.





- Pupils push themselves and work harder.
- The reward system cultivates positivity throughout the school.
- Achievement can be recognised and celebrated at every stage and every level.
- Award ceremonies and assemblies can be run to recognise the achievements which create excitement and engagement.
- By rewarding the pupils with the best learning habits and whose efforts have improved the most, results in these top pupils becoming models for other pupils to learn from.

Schools can also implement the Colour award system using embroidered or woven patches instead of pin badges.

# The Benefits:

- Patches as Colours can be applied to PE kits, especially sports.
- Patches as Colours are more permanent and are less likely to be lost.
- Patches as Colours are cheaper.
- Patches as Colours are bigger and more colourful and stand-out more than pin badges.


